Fortunately, in our neck of the woods we do not have the ferocity of hurricanes to contend with, thank goodness, except for subsequent storms or rains that may reach our area as a result. But often in winter months we do have the threat of ice and snowstorms in our forecast and we may find ourselves racing to the stores to stock up on items such as bread and milk and bottled water or other food items to carry us through in the event we are homebound and unable to get out to the store or even out of power for an unknown length of time. We know firsthand the panic that went through many as we saw shortages of toilet paper among other things last year due

to the fears caused by the pandemic.

Wouldn't it be great if in those times of uncertainty and impending doom we armed ourselves with the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist, sought out the Adoration Chapel and grabbed our Rosaries even before we rushed out the door to stock up on groceries or gas.

vere storm, I do the same. I grab my Rosary and light candles and pray for safety for all.

So let us remember that it is a good thing to plan and prepare for possible disasters, but it is even better to care for our souls before our personal comfort. Let us not be caught unaware. For though we may have warnings of storms or other possible looming catastrophes, we will not necessarily have warning of our personal end time. "...the Lord will come like a thief at night." 1Thessalonians 5:2. We must prepare ourselves for His coming.
