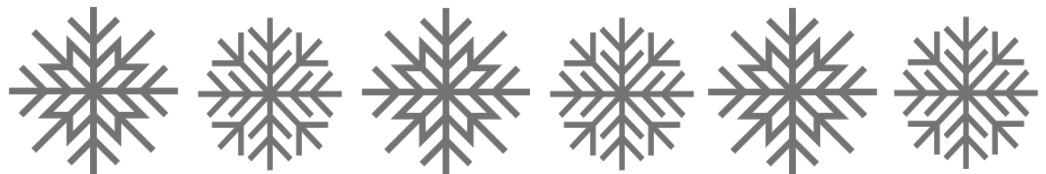

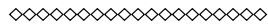

SENIOR KNIGHT OF THE YEAR, KNIGHT OF THE YEAR, AND FAMILY OF THE YEAR AWARDS 2021

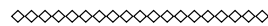

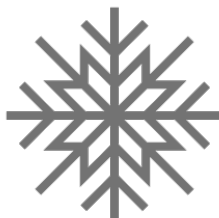
Note: We voted at the most recent meeting; due to increasing costs of operation; Ball Room rentals will increase to \$3000 in 2023.

The chalice engraved with the Sir Knight's name is presented to the family, and then delivered to the recipient by representatives of the assembly according to the Sir Knight's wishes. Wherever the chalice may be delivered, it will be used

in the holy sacrifice of the Mass, and there he will be remembered. At this time, I would also like to thank the members of the Honor Guard who participated in the wake service and funeral procession of Sir Knight Marion Bohnak.
