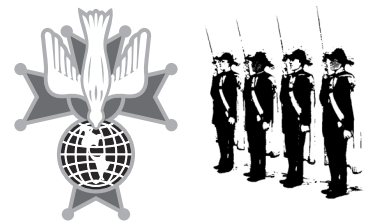
NEWS FROM THE 4TH DEGREE
