Sir Knight Joseph Wetmore served as Chancellor, Deputy Grand Knight and ultimately Grand Knight for Council 1580 for two consecutive terms in the fraternal years of 2014 - 2016. He then became the District Deputy for District 83 for the fraternal years of 2017 - 2021, supporting councils in Edwardsville, Collinsville, Greenville and Highland. He currently serves as Faithful Navigator for Highland Assembly 0231 and is committed to the organization's growth. He also serves as Assistant Diocesan Chairman for the Springfield Diocese.
